

Concerns



You are most welcome to make an appointment with the class teacher or the Headteacher if you have any concerns or require information on your child's progress. If we have any concerns we will invite you in to discuss these with us.

From time to time, parents and others connected with the school, may have wider concerns. To encourage resolution of such situations the Governing Body has adopted the Local Authority Complaints Procedure.

The procedure is devised with the intention that it will:

- Usually be possible to resolve problems by informal means
- Be simple to use and understand
- Be non-adversarial
- Provide confidentiality
- Allow problems to be handled swiftly
- Address all the points at issue
- Inform future practice so that the problem is unlikely to recur.

Full details of the procedure may be obtained from the school office or from the Clerk to the Governing Body.

CHILD PROTECTION

The school has a responsibility to safeguard all children. All staff and regular parent helpers are police checked. The school follows the Local Authority recommended procedures for child protection.

Any concerns reported by parents, visitors or staff to the designated child protection teachers (the Head teacher and Assistant Head, or to the SENDco in their absence) are followed up according to the legal requirements and in strict confidence.

Outside agencies are involved as appropriate and parents are kept informed.
