
School Routines



At playtimes the children are supervised in the playground by members of staff at the morning and afternoon break and at lunchtimes by the mid-day supervisors.

The playground markings and special playtime equipment encourage the children to play games and the quiet area provides seating for children who wish to play quieter games or talk. When the weather is fine the children are also able to play on the grass. Outside play for Foundation Stage children is an important part of their planned curriculum and takes place every day.

All staff hold first aid certificates and can help children who are unwell or hurt. If we have any concerns about your child we will contact you.

Please ensure your child is collected on time. If you are unavoidably delayed, please telephone the school so that we can reassure your child.

Supervision: children are supervised throughout the day and we ask that a child who has to leave school during the day is collected by an adult. Adults should report to the office first where a member of staff will collect your child.
