

## Overview

The Sports funding is used to enable the school to provide specialist coaching provision, offer after school activities, enable inter school competitions and maintain its swimming program.

**The total amount allocated to the school for the financial year 2015 to 2016 (April 15 – March 16) was £8 485.**

## How will the money be spent in this academic year?

- To improve teaching and learning in sports and PE. By providing specialist sports coaches to improve the teaching and learning in PE and sports lessons. **(Anticipated cost £4800)**
- To encourage enthusiasm in other forms of exercise by providing dedicated dance lessons for EYFS and KS1. **(Anticipated cost £2200)**
- To widen participation, encouraging the least active children to attend by providing after schools for sports, KS1 gymnastics and KS2 dance **(included in costs above)**
- To provide opportunities for inter-school tournaments per term.**(£300)**
- To carry out risk assessment and H&S checks to ensure all equipment is safe to use and to maintain all PE and sporting equipment to a high standard.**(£425)**
- To ensure the school has qualified pool carers and teaching staff, and to maintain the swimming pool within legislation H&S guidance so that children can access swimming lessons daily from May to July.**(£560)**

## The impact of the expenditure.

Children learnt six different sports in the course of the year and were able to extend their skills through after school clubs and tournaments with local schools. In addition, children were involved children in after gymnastics. By the end of the Summer term 2015, over 90% of children within key stages 1 and 2 were swimming lengths successfully.
